Due to limited parking availability on Belle Isle, we have secured parking at Wayne State University for our participants. Shuttles will pick up participants at WSU and transport to and from Belle Isle. Each sponsor will receive one (1) VIP parking space on the island. Parking: Wayne State University Parking Structure 1


450 W Palmer, Detroit, MI 48202 – corner of Cass and Palmer. Use gates 3, 4, 0r 5 only \$5/car, Visa, MasterCard, and Discover ONLY. No cash or AMEX per WSU policy

Shuttle: Wayne State University Law School

The Law School is right across the street from Parking Structure 1. We will provide shuttle via Detroit Public School Busses – 11 standard busses and 1 wheelchair accessible bus.

Shuttles will begin at 5:30am and continue until 10:00am. Return shuttles begin at 11:00am through 1:00pm. There is no charge for the shuttle.

Volunteer parking attendants and crossing guards will be on site. No WSU staff will be on site.

It is possible to self-park closer to Belle Isle and walk across the MacArthur bridge. If walking or riding a bike across the bridge, follow Sunset Drive to the right and stay on as it curves around to the south side

of the island. The Sponsor Expo (our main event space) is located at the Athletic Complex/Event Space 3 at Strand Drive and Vista Avenue. There is no charge to walk or ride a bike onto the island.

So why shuttle? There is very limited parking on Belle Isle. Under state law, once parking reaches a certain capacity, the park must close its gates until cars exit the island. There are other events on the island Sunday – imagine the impact if the gates had to close before all our participants were shuttled over. Please utilize Wayne State University parking and ride the shuttle.

The Detroit Race for the Cure is a 5K Run or Walk. All runners will receive chip-timed bibs, which can be picked up at the Bib tent near Registration. Refer to map below for tent locations.
